Courses

- The language of instruction at Taiwan Tech is mainly Chinese; however, the university offers more than 160 courses in English each semester at Graduate Level, and more English-taught courses are developing at the Undergraduate level.
- An Engineering program at the Undergraduate level, *International Advanced Technology Program (IATP)*, is available in English. <https://iatp.ntust.edu.tw/>
- Course selection information will be announced by the Academic Affairs Office. Course lists are usually announced 1-2 months before the semester starts.

If the course list is not available for the 2026 Fall semester (115-1), you could refer to the 2025 Fall (114-1) instead as most courses will be similar but subject to change.

Minimum Credits or course selection regulation per semester

Bachelor: 9 credits. Students in the last year of bachelor's level are allowed to take courses at the Master's level.

Master: 1 course. Students could take courses in different departments.

Ph.D.: 1 course. Students could take courses in different departments.

Note: 1 credit = 16 teaching hours, 1 course = 2 or 3 credits.

Each course lasts a semester (16 weeks). 1 credit is equal to 2 ECTS credits.

Free Mandarin Courses

The Mandarin courses at Taiwan Tech are designed especially for international students and other Mandarin learners. This program focuses on daily conversation on various topics, such as eating, clothing, living, transportation, and entertainment. The courses are offered by the Language Center, and a placement test will be conducted at the beginning of the semester.

Exchange Student Application Procedure

- (1) Students who wish to join our exchange program should be nominated by their home university. Please inform us of the quota you'd like to nominate. Nomination deadline by April 15th and Oct. 15th.
- (2) Partner universities will receive a nomination link with access to the nomination system. Please submit the nominee's information, and students will receive a link for the application. All application documents are to be uploaded to the platform. Hard copies are not required for the application.
- (3) Once accepted, students and coordinators could download the **Letter of Acceptance** online.
